The SAH Diversity Committee has been busy this academic year with several activities. These activities include (a) collaborating with the HPPI to provide outreach to local elementary schools, (b) updating the resource of scholarship listings for students interested in applying to KU Medical Center.

(A) **Health Professions Pipeway Initiative (HPPI)** The committee has collaborated with Nedra Bonds at HPPI to assure that various planned activities had speakers or participants. The committee participated both as speakers and by locating speakers to staff these events.
